


Deltoid Muscle

English: Deltoid muscle
Latin: *Musculus deltoideus*



Deltoid muscle (lat. *musculus deltoideus*) is a large muscle forming a shoulder. It arises from the spine of the scapula (*spina scapulae*), from the lateral part of the clavicle and from the acromion. It inserts into *tuberositas deltoidea humeri*.

This muscle is innervated by the axillary nerve.
