

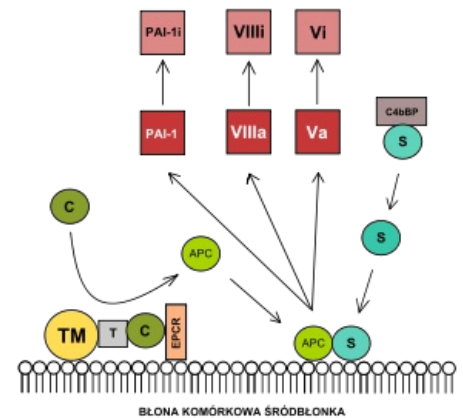
APC Resistance

Resistance to activated protein C (APC-R) is caused by mutations in the gene for **factor V Leiden** called Leiden mutation. It is the most common inherited disorder associated with venous thrombosis.
