


# Antitrombin III



**Antithrombin III** is a glycoprotein formed in the liver. It is an anticoagulant

agent that inactivates thrombin and some other coagulation factors (IX, X, XI and XII). The anticoagulant effect of antithrombin III increases many times in the presence of heparin, with which antithrombin III forms complexes.
