

Blumberg's sign

We are slowly pushing on the abdominal wall. With rapid release, **pain** will appear **at the site of pressure**. The phenomenon is caused by peritoneal irritation, pain occurs at the site of the inflammatory process. Together with the Rovsing and Plénies signs, it is typical of acute appendicitis.
