

# Colorectal cancer/prognosis

The five-year survival of individuals with KR-CA varies according to the stage at which the disease is detected. <sup>[1]</sup>

Stage	Five-year survival
St. 0 and 1	80-90%
St. 2	60-80%
St. 3	50-60%
St. 4	4-10%

In general, there is a much greater chance of five-year survival in individuals who are asymptomatic at the time of diagnosis (90%) compared to individuals who have had problems lasting three (40%) or seven (25%) months at the time of diagnosis. <sup>[1]</sup> **Prevention and screening program** are therefore important in this disease.
