Emergency/acute pain, oral surgery, perio, restorative and endodontic are all pre-requisites to having any type of prosthetic treatment

The oral mucosa/dentition should be stable, healthy state.

Orthodontic correction is required to be completed before hand.

In fixed partial dentures this could include: Mesial/molar tipping

Crown lengthening to improve retention form
