Dizziness (also known as **vertigo** – i.e. dizziness of rotational nature) along with the balance disorders are among the symptoms of vestibular disorders. We differentiate between dizzinesses of **vestibular origin** and **central origin**.^[1]

Dizziness syndrome is a condition accompanied by feelings of insecurity, false sense of moving or spinning, loss of balance and vegetative symptoms.

Dizziness can be caused by:

- intoxication
- ischemia,
- inflammation,
- tumors,
- trauma,...
