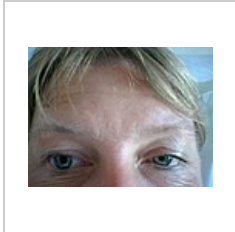


# Enophthalmos

**Enophthalmos** means an eye stuck in the orbit. It occurs either due to atrophy of the **fat pad** or to **enlarge the orbit**, or a combination thereof. Ex. **orbital injuries** (blow out fracture, atrophy from damage to the nerve supply and nutrition), metastases of scarhot cancers (breast or stomach). It occurs in Horner's syndrome, where it is more likely.
