Erythropenia (erythrocytopenia) is a decrease in the number of red blood cells below physiological levels. The number of erythrocytes in men is $4.3\text{--}5.3 \times 10^{12}/\text{l}$ of blood, in women $3.8\text{--}4.8 \times 10^{12}/\text{l}$ of blood.
