


# Help:Templates for formatting parts of text

There are now new templates in WikiScripts that make it much easier to mark up text more specifically.

These templates **modify** the text inserted into them **according** to uniformly **predefined styles'**, which you can read about in their **documentation**, where examples of their use are also given.

## What will it actually look like?

Template	What you write	What it will look like
Good example	<div>{{Good example The text you want on the light green line(s).}}</div>	<div>The text you want on the light green line(s).</div>
Wrong example	<div>{{Wrong example The text you want on the light pink line(s).}}</div>	<div>The text you want on the light pink line(s).</div>
Example	<div>{{Example Here you type the text you want to be indented, in italics and on a light blue background.}}</div>	<div><i>Here you type the text you want to be indented, in italics and on a light blue background.</i></div>
Cave	<div>{{Cave Type the text you want to be bold here, preceded by an exclamation mark to indicate the importance of the text.}}</div>	<div></div>
Petit	<div>{{Petit Here you write the text you want, to be written in petit.}}</div>	<div>Here you write the text you want, to be written in petit.</div>
Note	<div>{{Note Here you write the text you want, to be blue-grey underlined, indented from the left and a little smaller.}}</div>	<div><div>Here you write the text you want, to be blue-grey underlined, indented from the left and a little smaller.</div></div>
Strikethrough	<div>&lt;del&gt;Type the text you want to be crossed out here.&lt;/del&gt;.</div>	<div>Type the text you want to be crossed out here.</div>
