

# Hepatosplenomegaly

Hepatosplenomegaly is a combination of hepatomegaly and splenomegaly, i.e., it is the enlargement of the liver and spleen.

It occurs in **hematological diseases** with accelerated extramedullary hematopoiesis. It also occurs in **infectious diseases** (infectious mononucleosis, malaria, tuberculosis, typhoid fever, brucellosis, intestinal leishmaniasis), **cardiovascular diseases** (right heart failure), **metabolic diseases** (Gaucher disease) or **liver diseases** (liver cirrhosis).
