

# Liposarcoma

**Liposarcoma** is a malignant tumor that occurs most frequently in the retroperitoneum and subcutaneous tissue of the lower limb. It is distinguished from other sarcomas by its *yellow color*. **Microscopically**, it consists of uni- and multivacuolar cells (with "wrinkled" nuclei), histologically it can be well differentiated, round cell, myxoid, pleomorphic and dedifferentiated.
