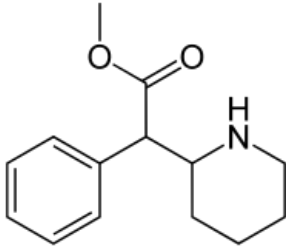


# Methylphenidate



Template:HVL P is a drug used in the treatment of ADHD, narcolepsy and hypersomnia<sup>[1]</sup>. It belongs to amphetamines. Increases dopamine levels. Continuous monitoring and titration of the dose is important during treatment. Side effects include ticks.
