


Proerythroblast

Proerythroblast is the **first** microscopically recognizable precursor of hematopoiesis. It is a relatively large cell, with a **large round nucleus** and one or two nucleoli. Free ribosomes in the cytoplasm cause mild **basophilia**. The next cell of the blood cell lineage is the **basophilic erythroblast**.
