

Prolonged healing of fractures

The term **prolonged fracture healing** means that the healing time is **longer** than the expected healing time of the fracture (6-8 weeks).

It's being resolved:

- by **prolonging immobilization**;
- in fractures conservatively treated by operative osteosynthesis;
- sometimes spongionoplasty is also performed.
