So we had to delete it, but we should replace it. We usually use images from Wikimedia Commons as Michaela Romerova said. All the images uploaded on this web portal are free for use (there is permission to use them). You can use it the same way as images uploaded to WikiLectures (you do not have to even upload on WikiLectures):


