- D01 – Antimycotics for use in dermatology
- D02 – Emollient and protectant
- D03 – Preparations for the treatment of wounds and ulcers
- D04 – Antipruritic including antihistamines, anesthetics, etc.
- D05 – Antipsoriatics
- D06 – Antibiotics and chemotherapeutics for use in dermatology
- D07 – Corticosteroids, dermatology
- D08 – Antiseptic and disinfectant
- D09 – Medicinal dressings
- D10 – Preparations for the treatment of acne
- D11 – Other dermatological preparations
