

Adenoameloblastoma

Adenoameloblastoma is an **odontogenic** adenomatoid tumor. It is a **benign** and **nonrecurrent** tumor .

Occurence

- Typical in young people (up to 20 years).
- Occurrence is up to twice as common in the maxilla as in the mandible
- Most often in the area from the second incisor to the premolar.

Description

The **X- ray** shows a sharply demarcated **clearing**. Adenoameloblastoma is small (1-3 cm) and very **fibrous** . In the section we see a whitish-gray tissue containing one or more cysts with a yellowish jelly-like content. The presence of epithelial structures that resemble glandular alveoli is characteristic.
