

# Anomaly of the vestibulum oris, diastema, tremata

## Anomaly of the vestibulum oris

- Shallow vestibulum
  1. Primary shallow vestibulum
    - Congenital
    - High attachment of mentalis muscle
  1. Secondary shallow vestibulum
    - due to gingival recession (missing of attached gingiva)
  
- Anomaly in attachment of labial frenulum
  1. Gingival attachment (normally the attachment is mucosal)
    1. Papillary attachment
    1. Through the papilla attachment

### PULL SYMPTOM

- The gingiva around the pathological attachment of the frenulum has whitish (pale) colour

### PULL SYNDROME

- Follows pull symptom
- Results in opening of the interdental space between the two central incisors (diastema formation)

## Diastema

Space between the two central incisors

## Tremata

- Single space --> trema
- Many spaces --> tremata (spacing)
