

# Derealization



**Derealization** is a disorder of perception (or experience) in which a person's subjective dissociation from the environment occurs. The affected person feels as if everything is "*like in a movie*", "*behind the glass*", "*behind the curtain*", "*like in a dream*", etc. It is often accompanied by depersonalization . It is present in a number of psychological disorders, intoxications, but also in the healthy population (in stressful situations, etc.).
