

Eidetism



Eidetism is the ability of a person to form a very vivid image of something he has just seen or heard. It occurs in artists and children.^[1] In cognitive psychology, special images are used, after viewing which a person looks, for example, at a white wall and the motif from the image appears on it (Greek *eidon* means seen) ^[2] in this case, it is a pseudo-illusion .
