

# Enthesopathy

**Entesopathies** are pain syndromes caused by inflammatory + degenerative processes in the area of tendon, ligament and joint capsule attachments.

The most common ones are:

- Achilles tendon enthesopathy + plantar aponeurosis on the heel bone (calcaneus).
- Enthesopathy of the gluteus medius muscle on the trochanter major
- Enthesopathy of attachment of the hand extensors to the radial epicondylus ( *radial epicondylitis, tennis elbow* ).
- Enthesopathy of attachment of hand flexors to ulnar epicondylus ( *ulnar epicondylitis, golfer's elbow* ).

## Therapy

- ▪ Elimination of provocative factors.
- ▪ NSAIDs locally + systematically .
- ▪ Local instillation of glucocorticoids .
- ▪ Rehabilitation (physical procedures).
