The **lesser supraclavicular fossa** (*fossa supraclavicularis minor*) is a topographical location located on the neck in the sternocleidomastoid region. It is the space between the two origins of the sternocleidomastoid muscle on the clavicle a sternum. The pleural cupula or *cupula pleurae*.

Boundary

- **Medially and laterally** - sternocleidomastoid muscle;
- **Caudally** - clavicle.
