

Mobiluncus

Bacteria of the genus *Mobiluncus* are **gramlabile anaerobic mobile rods**. They are isolated in women with **bacterial vaginosis**, often together with *Gardenerella vaginalis* and other bacteria. At the same time, they are a finding in women without clinical symptoms. This genus includes *M. curtisii* and *M. mulieris*
