

Mononeuritis multiplex



Mononeuritis multiplex is the term used for involvement of two or more peripheral nerves from predominantly systemic causes. These can be, for example, **W**egener's granulomatosis, **A**IDS/**A**myloidosis , **R**heumatoid arthritis, **D**iabetes mellitus, **S**arcoidosis , **P**olyarteritis nodosa, **L**eprosy, **C**arcinomatosis (**WARDS PLC**).^[1]
