

Musculus brachialis

Musculus brachialis belongs to the anterior group of muscles of the arm. A large part of its course is covered by the biceps, which crosses over it.

Beginning: anterior surface of the *humerus*, from the attachment of the *m. deltoideus* to the elbow joint.

Extension: *tuberositas ulnae* to *proc. coronoideus ulnae*.

Innervation: *n. musculocutaneus* (C5 and C6).

Function: flexion at the elbow joint.

Vascular supply: *a. brachialis*




Image of the Brachialis muscle.
