

# Musculus risorius

**Musculus risorius** is formed by transverse bundles that go from the parotidomasseteric fascia to the corner of the mouth and to the outer edge of the depressor anguli oris muscle .

**Vascular supply:** a. facialis.

**Innervation:** n. facialis.

**Function:** pulls the corner of the mouth to the side when laughing.
