

Opisthotonus

Opisthotonus is a symptom.

- This is a **specific position** of the back, in which the patient rests on his head and heels with his body bent forward into an arch due to spasm of the back muscles.
- Opisthotonus can be a symptom of **tetanus**, **eclampsia**, or **hysteria**.
