

Pipkin's classification

The **Pipkin classification** divides **femoral head fractures** into **types I-IV**.

- **type I** – the fracture is distal to the fovea capitis
- **type II** – the fracture is proximal to the fovea capitis
- **type III** – fracture of the head at the same time as fracture of the neck of the femuru
- **type IV** – type I, II or III at the same time as an acetabular fracture
