

Polycythemia

Polycythemia is an increase in the number of red blood cells above the physiological limit. The normal number of erythrocytes in a healthy adult individual is $4.3\text{-}5.3 \cdot 10^{12}/\text{l}$ of blood for men and $3.8\text{-}4.8 \cdot 10^{12}/\text{l}$ for women.
