

Serratus anterior muscle

Origin: 1.-9. rib.

Insertion: medial edge scapulae, angulus inferior scapulae (4th-9th tooth).

Innervation: nervus thoracicus longus (C5-C7) – pars supraclavicularis plexus brachialis.

Function:

- holding the scapula to the chest;
- when pulling for a lower angle, turning the scapula outward;
- auxiliary inspiratory muscle.
