

Strangulation




Strangulation is used in two senses:

Squeezing the throat with an object (throttle, hand) – according to the mechanism, we distinguish between strangulation, hanging, suffocation. Asphyxia occurs, death occurs by suffocation.

2. *Nerve vascular constriction* – causes non-bleeding and gangrene of the affected area (intestines).

Bowel constriction when entering a pathological cleft.
