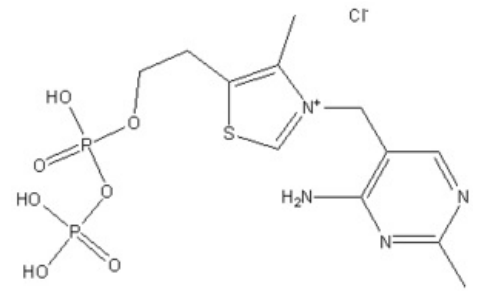


Thiamine pyrophosphate
