

# Transcellular liquid

**Transcellular fluid** is an extracellular fluid that is found in **body cavities** bounded by an epithelial layer and is created based on the secretory activity of cells (e.g. cerebrospinal fluid, synovial, intraocular, interpleural and pericardial fluids, etc.). It makes up about 1% of total body weight.
